What happened to negotiations?

On April 6, 2016, after WTU rejected the last DCPS offer for agreement (including teacher pay)—a proposal made in the absence of Chancellor Henderson—Geo Johnson, the Mediator facilitating negotiations, excused himself from the bargaining table with the promise that he would return upon request.

After many attempts to schedule new dates and a formal letter of notice to resume bargaining—only silence from DCPS.

Why don't I have a contract now?

Your WTU negotiations team has agreed that any contract that does not offer the professionals in the classroom the respect and support they are due is a non-starter. We've done it their way for eight years—our teachers and students can't afford more of the same.

When will I get a contract?

We are ready to go back to the table and collectively bargain in good faith for a reasonable, but fair, contract for our members. Will DCPS do the same?

What can I do?
